Program Descriptions

Hawks and Falcons (all ages)- What is the difference between a hawk and a falcon? Come discover the world of diurnal (daytime) birds of prey. We'll cover their adaptations, what and how they hunt, and the challenges to them in the wild. You'll get to meet our Red-Tailed hawk and American Kestrel.

Owls (all ages)- Owls can be found throughout Maryland. We'll explore what types of owls are found here, their adaptations as well as challenges. You'll get to meet one of our owls, either a barred owl or barn owl.

Nocturnal and Diurnal Birds of Prey (3rd-Adult)- What's the difference between nocturnal and diurnal birds of prey? We'll explore this question and much more in this longer format program. Birds may include a Red-Tailed Hawk, American kestrel, Barn Owl, or Barred Owl.

Whooo's Flying? Hawks and owls (K-3rd)- This program is specially designed for our “little fliers” and focuses on what is a bird, and the adaptations of birds of prey. We’ll meet at least one nocturnal and one diurnal bird.

Festivals/Tabling - We offer live birds for tabling events of all types. Please ask about our minimum requirements related to space, shade, and parking. The number of birds depends on the event and length of the program. Birds will be on display with intervals between for rest.
